- Copy of FAA Medical Certificate¹
- Copy of Photo Identification
- \$150 non-refundable student Registration Fee²
- Evidence of Funds to demonstrate money is available to pay for training³

Transportation Security Administration (TSA) Regulations

Under Transportation Security Administration (TSA) regulations U.S. students training for their first aviation rating, or an instrument rating, are required to prove their citizenship status before we can commence flight training. Please make sure you bring with you the following:

- U.S. Passport; or
- Original U.S. birth certificate and a government issued picture identification (driver's license); or
- Original U.S. naturalization certificate with raised seal, USCIS or INS form N-550 or N-570 (Certificate of Naturalization) and a government issued picture identification (driver's license)

NOTE: *If you are a U.S. permanent resident, but not a U.S. citizen please contact Bristow Academy as a TSA procedure needs to be followed.*

¹ *If you are taking the Professional Pilot Program you will need a Class 2 Medical Certificate. [FAA approved doctors](#)*

² *Payment can be made by check or credit card. Credit card payment requires a completed authorization form to be submitted with your documents.*
